Mobile unit serving Allegany and Garrett Counties with assistance to overcome poverty; services include home visits, screening for benefits, and referrals to families to access private resources locally—such as daily meal programs, eviction prevention assistance, free tax preparation services, utility assistance and more

St. Anthony Place | 300 East Oldtown Rd., Cumberland

Emergency help led by volunteers to assist invididuals and families in need (within a 50-mile radius), with food, clothing, cleaning supplies, rent and utilities assistance

Parish-based Programs (partial list)

- Monthly collection of food, food gift cards and money to assist the less fortunate in partnership with organizations such as the Food Connect, Frostburg Food Pantry, Georges Creek Food Panty, and Tri-Towns Food Panty
- Support for mothers and children in crisis: maternity clothes, diapers, cribs, clothing and other new baby items
- Saint Vincent DePaul Society, volunteer support, including food and other assistance for people suffering from the effects of poverty

HEALTH CARE AND RELATED SERVICES

- Behavioral health services
 - Including individual counseling, family counseling, psychiatric evaluation, social and coping skill development, medication management, and substance use disorder services
- School-based mental health services

Licensed therapists help with emotional and behavioral issues that can impact students in Allegany County schools at school and at home: improve behavior and school work habits, develop coping and relationship skills, and manage anxiety and depression. Parents and caregivers get support, information and guidance leading to better communication and a less stressful home.
