COMMUNITY RESOURCES

Parish-based programs offer many services and programs, including financial assistance for rent and utility relief, prescription assistance; food pantries; and parish nursing

Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Washington

offers a wide range of services for residents, including

- **Catholic Charities Center:** serves all of Montgomery County: Case management, crisis intervention and referral, food pantry and mobile produce distribution, clothing/diapers, parent education, financial education, rent/mortgage/utility assistance and more
- **Community Companions**
Child care for children with disabilities: after-school, in-home support, caregiver respite, camps
- **Community Options**
Engaging and safe environment for persons with disabilities, including nursing, therapies, community integration and activities
- **Employment Programs for Adults with Disabilities**
Support for adults with developmental disabilities to enter the workforce
- **Family Peace**
Prevents family abuse and promotes family peace by training archdiocesan first responders to recognize the symptoms of domestic violence, respond with compassion and refer survivors to assistance
- **Family Support Program | Spanish Catholic Center**
Case management, assistance with food, clothing and shelter; access to Catholic Charities' medical and dental clinics, SNAP benefits
- **Financial Stability Network**
Pro bono financial services: financial coaching, education and tax assistance for low-income families
- **Immigration Services** | Pro bono legal services for foreign-born individuals/families, plus Newcomer Network, training and employment assistance and English as a second language
- **Legal Network**
Pro bono legal services including issues with debt, employment, family law, landlord-tenant, public benefits, wills and probate, guardianship and conservatorship

- **Parish Partners Program**
Connects Catholic parishes assisting local families with Catholic Charities' expertise and services; support for the development of parish social ministries; county emergency service guide
- **Sanctuaries for Life**
Support for women facing an unintended pregnancy through a network of emotional, material and spiritual support during and beyond pregnancy, including prenatal care, labor/delivery
- **SHARE Food Network**
Wholesome and nutritious food at a reduced cost through host sites
- **Strong Families Initiative**
Provides Latino youth an outlet to discuss hardships they are facing, to be better equipped to face future difficulties
- **Trafficking Victims Assistance Program**
Comprehensive and strength-based services for children and adult survivors of human trafficking
- **Welcome Home Reentry Program**
Volunteer mentoring to men and women returning to their communities after incarceration

St. Peter's House | Olney

Residence for women with intellectual disabilities to live independently, with the support and sponsorship of St. Peter's parish in Olney; developed through Rosaria Communities of the Archdiocese of Washington

Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Washington

health care services available to residents include

- **Anchor Mental Health Counseling** | Individual counseling and therapeutic groups
- **Health Care Network** | Connects low-income and uninsured patients with specialized, pro bono health care services
- **Catholic Charities Dental Clinic** | services on a sliding scale
- **Catholic Charities Volunteer Medical Clinic**
Volunteer doctors, nurses and other healthcare professionals provide free primary care to adults without access to medical care through public benefits or private insurance
