SENIOR SERVICES

Archdiocese of Baltimore programs include:

- **Answers for the Aging** | Free information and referral service addressing questions about services for older adults, families, friends and caregivers
- **Senior Support Services** | Helps residents of senior communities live independently, with services including meals, housekeeping, laundry, and personal care

COMMUNITY RESOURCES

Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Washington

offers a wide range of programs for residents of District 21, including

- **Community Companions** | Child care for children with disabilities: after-school, in-home support, caregiver respite, camps
- **Community Options**
Engaging and safe environment for persons with disabilities, including nursing, therapies, community integration and activities
- **Employment Programs for Adults with Disabilities**
Support for adults with developmental disabilities to enter the workforce
- **Family Peace** | Trains archdiocesan first responders to recognize the symptoms of domestic violence, respond with compassion and refer survivors to assistance
- **Immigration Services** | Pro bono legal services, Newcomer Network, employment training and assistance and English as a second language
- **Legal Network** | Pro bono legal services addressing debt, employment, family law, landlord-tenant, public benefits, wills and probate, guardianship and conservatorship
- **Parish Partners Program**
Connects Catholic parishes assisting local families with Catholic Charities' expertise and services; county emergency service guide
- **Sanctuaries for Life**
Support for women facing an unintended pregnancy through a network of emotional, material and spiritual support during and beyond pregnancy, including prenatal care, labor/delivery
- **Strong Families Initiative**
Provides Latino youth an outlet to discuss hardships they are facing, to be better equipped to face future difficulties
- **Trafficking Victims Assistance Program**
Comprehensive and strength-based services for children and adult survivors of human trafficking

- **Villa Maria of Anne Arundel County**
Behavioral health services including individual counseling, family counseling, psychiatric evaluation, social and coping skill development, medication management, and substance use disorder services
- **Gallagher Services**
Supports adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities through residential services, supported employment, community-based day services, respite care, employment training services, pre-vocational and vocational training, spiritual, recreational and social activities, and personal supports
- **Family Support Groups**
Support groups for families who have a member with mental/behavioral health challenges
- **Sarah's House**
Emergency and transitional housing plus other services for homeless families in Anne Arundel County
