## COMMUNITY RESOURCES

Catholic Charities programs include

- **Family Support Groups**  
Resource for families who have a member with mental/behavioral health challenges
- **Gallagher Services**  
Supports adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities through residential services, supported employment, community-based day services, respite care, employment training services, pre-vocational and vocational training, spiritual, recreational and social activities, and personal supports
- **Sarah's House**  
Emergency and transitional housing plus other services for homeless families in Anne Arundel County

**St. Vincent de Paul Society** provides a range of support for local residents suffering from the effects of poverty: emergency financial assistance to local residents for rent, utilities, medicine, food, work- or medical-related transportation, and funerals, as well as counseling and coordination of local social services. Approximately 1,000 families receive assistance annually.

### Christ Child Society of Annapolis

Celebrating 100 years of volunteer service to the community. Provides warm clothes, toys, and books for children from families facing financial difficulties, layettes for new mothers, and books for local middle schools.

**Prison ministry, environmental stewardship,** support for immigrants, new mothers, and partnering with the Greater Annapolis Interfaith Network are just some of the volunteer-based programs at the local parishes

## HEALTH CARE AND RELATED SERVICES

### Villa Maria of Anne Arundel County

- **Behavioral health services**  
Individual counseling, family counseling, psychiatric evaluation, social and coping skill development, medication management, and substance use disorder services
- **School-based mental health services**  
Licensed therapists help with emotional and behavioral issues that can impact students at school and at home: improve behavior and school work habits, develop coping and relationship skills, and manage anxiety and depression. Parents and caregivers get support, information and guidance leading to better communication and a less stressful home.
