HOUSING AND SERVICES FOR THE HOMELESS

Catholic Charities programs to support Baltimore residents:

- **Christopher Place Employment Academy**
Intensive residential program providing education, training, and recovery support to formerly homeless men of the Baltimore area
- **Earn Benefits**
Screening program for public benefits and financial assistance
- **Project FRESH Start**
Helps eligible homeless families find stable, affordable housing

St. Vincent de Paul

- **Sarah's Hope Family Shelter**
130-bed shelter serving homeless families in Baltimore City, with services including meals, youth activities and tutoring, adult education, case management, housing placement and referrals
- **Family Pathways** | Shelter diversion and homelessness prevention program serving 75 families per year

- **Elevate** | Personalized and financial support for college students on the path to graduation.
- **Gallagher Services**
Supports adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities through residential services, supported employment, community-based day services, respite care, employment training services, pre-vocational and vocational training, spiritual, recreational and social activities, and personal supports

- **Level Up** | Helps youth, 18-24, with specific obstacles, to find and keep employment
- **SHARE Food Network**
Community-based organization open to all, offering groceries at a discount through high-volume purchasing and volunteer support

- **Therapeutic After School Programs - Lansdowne**
