St. Ann's Center for Children, Youth and Families

4901 Eastern Ave., Hyattsville | Established 1860 by the Daughters of Charity; lifts vulnerable children, mothers and families out of poverty and homelessness through innovative programs: housing, employment and education counseling, parenting and life skills, an education center for high school completion, and clinical and social work services

- Transitional Housing Program | Faith House: 8 apartments for homeless mothers and their children and Hope House: transitional housing with access to support services and mentoring

COMMUNITY RESOURCES

Catholic Charities offers a range of programs to residents, including:

- Catholic Charities Center serves all of Montgomery County:
 Case management, crisis intervention and referral, food pantry and mobile produce distribution, clothing/diapers, parent education, financial education, rent/mortgage/utility assistance and more
- Family Peace
 - Prevents family abuse and promotes family peace by training archdiocesan first responders to recognize the symptoms of domestic violence, respond with compassion and refer survivors to assistance
- Immigration Services | Pro bono legal services for foreignborn individuals/families, plus Newcomer Network, training and employment assistance and English as a second language
- Legal Network

Pro bono legal services addressing debt, employment, family law, landlord-tenant, public benefits, wills and probate, guardianship and conservatorship

Connects Catholic parishes assisting local families with Catholic Charities' expertise and services; support for the development of parish social ministries; county emergency service guide

Sanctuaries for Life

Support for women facing an unintended pregnancy through a network of emotional, material and spiritual support during and beyond pregnancy, including prenatal care, labor/delivery

- Trafficking Victims Assistance Program
 Comprehensive and strength-based services for children and adult survivors of human trafficking
- Welcome Home Reentry Program
 Volunteer mentoring to men and women returning to their communities after incarceration

HEALTH CARE AND RELATED SERVICES

Catholic Charities programs available to residents include:

- Anchor Mental Health Counseling | Individual counseling and therapeutic groups
- Health Care Network | Connects low-income and uninsured patients with specialized, pro bono health care services
- Catholic Charities Dental Clinic
 Services on a sliding scale; Catholic Charities also hosts Mission of Mercy annually, free, one-day dental clinics held in Rockville
- Catholic Charities Volunteer Medical Clinic
 Volunteer doctors, nurses and other healthcare professionals provide
 free primary care to adults without access to medical care through
 public benefits or private insurance
