1. Poverty. The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) and other similar initiatives provide funding for millions of poor Americans who cannot afford to adequately feed themselves or their families. Congress should oppose restrictions on SNAP that prevent the most vulnerable from receiving these benefits.

Clinton	Spellman, Jr.	I am proposing a federal program called Poverty to Profession, a 10-to-14-week Program to prepare the Homeless, Incarcerated, low income unemployed for training for Certified blue collar career employment thru Apprenticeships and two-year college degree from Electricians to nursing. And working with unions that pay a livable of \$50,000 plus, through training thru Poverty to Profession. Also proposing to raise the Federal Minimum wage to \$21.85 an hour with a cost-of-living increase of 1.35 every 2
