Emergency help led by volunteers to assist individuals and families in need (within a 50-mile radius), with food, clothing, cleaning supplies, rent and utilities assistance

### Parish-based Programs *(partial list)*

- **Monthly collection of food, food gift cards and money** to assist the less fortunate in partnership with organizations such as the Food Connect, Frostburg Food Pantry, Georges Creek Food Panty, and Tri-Towns Food Panty

- **Support for mothers and children in crisis:** maternity clothes, diapers, cribs, clothing and other new baby items
- **Saint Vincent DePaul Society**, volunteer support, including food and other assistance for people suffering from the effects of poverty

- **Behavioral health services**  
Including individual counseling, family counseling, psychiatric evaluation, social and coping skill development, medication management, and substance use disorder services
- **School-based mental health services**  
Licensed therapists help with emotional and behavioral issues that can impact students in Allegany County schools at school and at home: improve behavior and school work habits, develop coping and relationship skills, and manage anxiety and depression. Parents and caregivers get support, information and guidance leading to better communication and a less stressful home.
