HEALTH CARE AND RELATED SERVICES

Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Baltimore

offers a wide range of health care services for residents of Baltimore County, including

- **Family Support Groups**
Program for families who have a member with mental/behavioral health challenges
- **Home-Based Respite Program**
Professional staff provide therapeutic opportunities for children with mental health challenges, while also giving a break to the caregiver
- **In-Home Intervention Programs**
Intensive in-home intervention to empower families, divert children from hospitalization or residential treatment, and maintain children in their homes
- **Therapeutic After School Programs**
Structured, therapeutic activities for children ages 5-13 facing moderate to severe behavioral and emotional challenges
- **Villa Maria Behavioral Health**
Mental health and substance use disorder treatment to adults, children and families, in-home respite services and public school partnerships
