

COMMUNITY RESOURCES

Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Baltimore offers a wide range of health care services for residents, including

Free information and referral service addressing questions about services for older adults, families, friends and caregivers

Parish outreach from St. Francis of Assisi

Volunteers provide a range of food support, including meals and food pantry donations, assistance for individuals in recovery, prison ministry, and support for expectant and new mothers.

Chaplaincy services at prisons, including Patuxent Institution, at Clifton T. Perkins Hospital, plus parish-based pastoral care for residents who are homebound, in nursing homes or in hospitals

HIGHER EDUCATION PROGRAM

Georgetown University Prisons and Justice Initiative Prison Scholars Program launched in 2022 at the Patuxent Institution in Jessup. Graduates of the program will earn a Bachelor of Liberal Arts. Classes are taught by Georgetown University faculty onsite at the prison.

Last year, 61 students were enrolled in the program. Students complete 120 credits in 5 years, starting with general education courses in philosophy, history, writing, math, science, social science and Spanish before selecting a major in humanities or social sciences.
