- **School-based mental health services**
Licensed therapists help with emotional and behavioral issues that can impact students in Frederick County schools at school and at home: improve behavior and school work habits, develop coping and relationship skills, and manage anxiety and depression. Parents and caregivers get support, information and guidance leading to better communication and a less stressful home.
