Catholic Charities

- **Basic Needs Program**
Support low-income households through financial crises with case management, financial literacy, budget counseling, job readiness, rent/mortgage/utility assistance, clothing, household goods, furniture, diapers, food, and referrals
- **Immigration Counseling**
Comprehensive immigration counseling to assist individuals and families in immigration and naturalization processes
- **Seton Center** | 30632 Hampden Ave., Princess Anne
Community center providing a food pantry, homelessness prevention, family strengthening services, immigration assistance, preventative healthcare, thrift store, women's support, and referral services

Diabetes Prevention

Free program for people at high risk for Type 2 diabetes: recognizing pre-diabetes and access to CDC-trained coaches to help participants make lifestyle changes that will reduce their risk of developing Type 2 diabetes

Pregnancy Counseling

Medical referrals, and pregnancy and parenting counseling to support expectant parents

Outpatient Counseling

Outpatient counseling for individuals with emotional, behavioral, and mental health concerns
